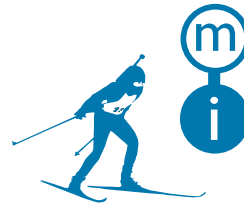




the megan report 2007

End result? 20th place. Though I am not happy with the shooting, I did everything I could in the moment to be the best. All in all, an excellent performance.

This entire event has been a career highlight, and I am extremely pleased with my improvement this year. I can move on to my next races with a new found confidence and a smile on my face.
