Here is a short update from the race today. I was 14th, so far an excellent start to the season.

Friday night I went to sleep to the sound of rain outside the Ganner Gasthaus in Obertilliach, Austria. This morning it had turned to a heavy snowfall...just in time for race day.

It was the first international race of the year today, Europa Cup # 1, the sprint race. The race track is very narrow, only one skier width wide. Until today, it was all man made snow.

I started in the first seed of 102 Junior women racers. I started at 2:57pm, in 15 second intervals. So the trail was hectic!

From the start the race went excellent, with a smooth first lap, avoiding the crashes was a talent in itself. The first range in prone went exactly as planned. It is a great feeling to speed passed the penalty loop!

My standing shooting was ok, not super, but acceptable. I hit 3/5, whipped off two penalty loops, and stuck with a German junior world medallist from last year, on my last lap. All in all a super race, and I am only in a better position to move up in tomorrow's pursuit.
